

# Ardlarach & Lerigoligan



(1.5 miles) This walk takes you on to the old road, which used to run down the middle of the peninsula rather than along the coast.

Start off walking towards Craobh Haven, but just past where the tarmac finishes take the right fork. Continue, bearing right at the next fork, just past the cattle grid, until you approach a cottage. The track runs in front of the cottage and up some stone steps leading to two chalets. At the top of the steps, turn right, go through the gate ahead of you and bear slightly right, uphill. Near the top of this slope, the track appears to peter out, but turn left on the grass and you will soon see it ahead of you again. Carry on to the top of the rise, then on down the track until you see houses below you and a gate on your right. Go through the gate and down the hill, eventually coming out in the village hall car park.
